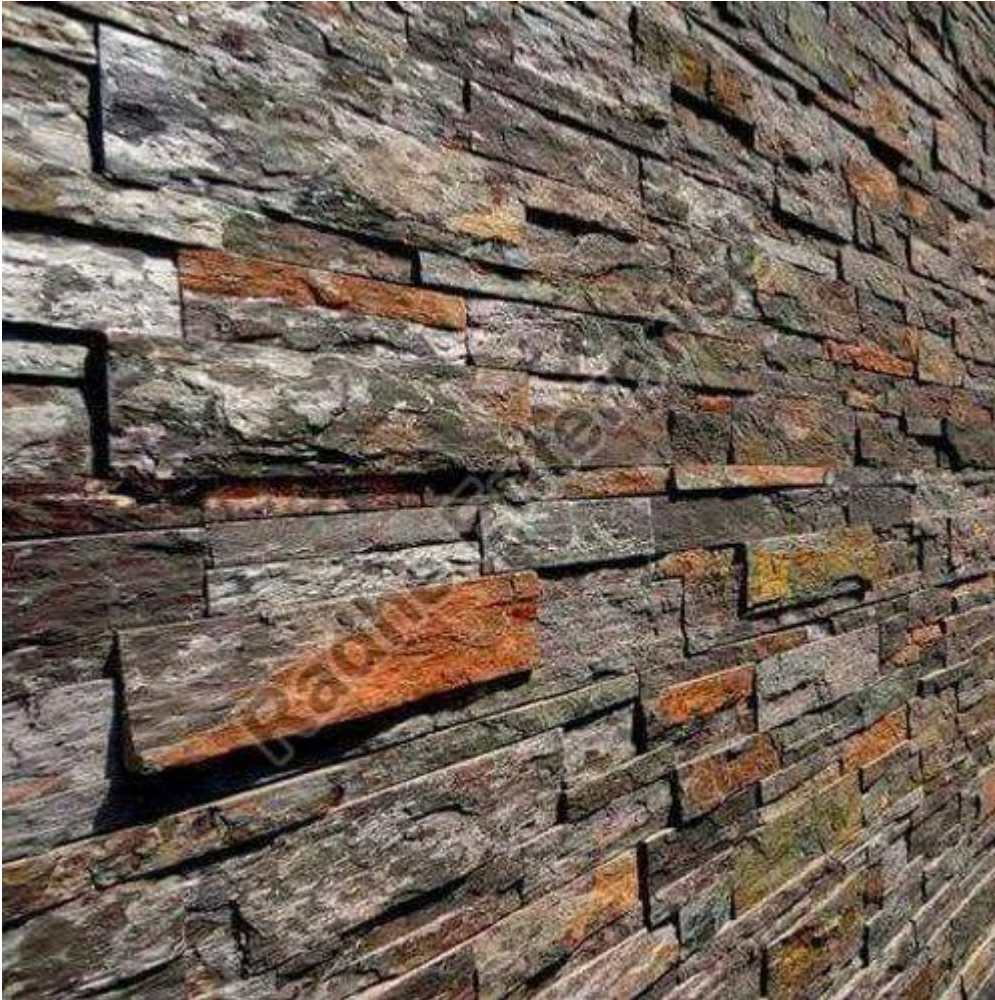


What is Antique Stone and Its Uses? | aa



The English word “antique” refers to a valuable, old item. The basic rule is that anything older than 100 years is regarded as antique. The history of old stone, however, is entirely different. People used to gather shattered rocks and pebbles to construct tools and equipment in the past. 8,000 BC saw the decoration of red pebbles with dots and wavy lines in what is now France and Spain.

These kinds of stones are often sold in two categories: natural and man-made. As the name suggests, natural antiques are created from fragments of natural stone, often travertine. However, the synthetic ancient stone is made from cement plastic, which comes in a variety of shades. The majority of antique stone is made up of travertine, marble, onyx, and traonyx treated in various ways.
