Chipmunks and field mice

Voles and moles

Black bears, which may wander into yards and feed on garbage or bird seed

Woodchucks, skunks, and opossums.

Beavers, which can cause problems by blocking up streams and causing flood damage

Bats, raccoons, squirrels, rats, mice, skunks, snakes, woodpeckers, pigeons, blackbirds, and more
