

Transient ischemic attack (TIA), commonly knownas a mini-stroke, is a condition in which the blood supply to part of thebrain is briefly interrupted by a clot or narrowed blood vessel andtemporarily stops bleeding flow. This cuts off oxygen and nutrients, causingtemporary symptoms. Some common symptoms of TIA include sudden weaknessor numbness on one side of the body; sudden blurred, or loss of vision in one or botheyes; sudden confusion or trouble speaking or understanding speech;sudden trouble walking or loss of balance or coordination; and sudden severeheadache. TIA is a warning sign and signal of a possible upcoming stroke. The detectionand treatment of TIA helps to prevent long term disability from stroke. Theglobal transient ischemic attack market offers devices and drugs to diagnoseand treat TIA. MRI systems, CT scanners and ultrasound devices are widelyused for TIA diagnosis.
