Types of Car Scratches

Before jumping into repairs, it's important to identify the type of scratch:

- 1. Surface Scratches Affect only the clear coatand are easy to fix.
- 2. Paint Scratches Penetrate the clear coat and touch the paint layer.
- 3. Deep Scratches Reach the primer or metaland require more extensive repair.

DIY Methods for Fixing Car Scratches

- 1. Using Toothpaste for Light Scratches
 - Wash the scratched area thoroughly.
 - Apply a small amount of toothpaste on amicrofiber cloth.
 - Rub in circular motions for a few minutes.
 - Wipe clean and repeat if necessary.
- Scratch Repair Pens for Paint Scratches



- Clean the area and let it dry.
- Shake the repair pen well and apply it to thescratch.
- Let it dry and buff gently with a microfiber cloth.
- Sanding and Polishing for Deeper Scratches
 - Wash and dry the car to remove dirt.
 - Use fine sandpaper (2000 grit) with water to smooth out the scratch.
 - Apply rubbing compound and buff with a clean cloth.
 - Finish with car wax for added protection.
- 4. Touch-Up Paint for Major Scratches
 - Find the right paint match for your car.
 - Clean and sand the affected area.
 - Apply primer (if necessary), then touch-up paint.
 - Let it dry and finish with clear coat and polishing.
