DIY Methods for Fixing Car Scratches

1. Using Toothpaste for Light Scratches

- Wash the scratched area thoroughly.
- Apply a small amount of toothpaste on a microfiber cloth.
- Rub in circular motions for a few minutes.
- Wipe clean and repeat if necessary.
