Then, users must sign out of devices that 'should nothave access' and change their passwords. In casesomeone outside their household is using Netflix, the profile can be transferred.

How to set up a Netflix household

Users must set up a Netflix household, which isbasically the TV that you use the most to watch Netflix. The company added that the devices that use the same internet connection as this TV willautomatically be a part of the users' NetflixHousehold.

To set up a Netflix household, users can followthese steps:

- 1. Sign in to Netflix using a TV that is connected toyour home internet.
- 2. Open the menu from the Netflix homescreen onyour TV and select Get Help and then ManageNetflix Household.
- 3. Click on the tab that says Confirm NetflixHousehold or Update My Netflix Household.
- 4. Now, choose from the Send Email or Send Textoption. As soon as you do that, a verification link willbe sent to the account email address or phonenumber that you have registered with Netflix. Thelink expires in 15 minutes, so be sure to act quicklyafter this. Also, in case you haven't added bothemail address and phone number, you will see onlyone option to verify.
- 5. Once you click on the verification link, select Yes, This Was Me. Then choose Confirm NetflixHousehold or Update Netflix Household to continue. That's it, you have done your part. A confirmationwill be displayed on your TV screen and you will also receive a confirmation email.
