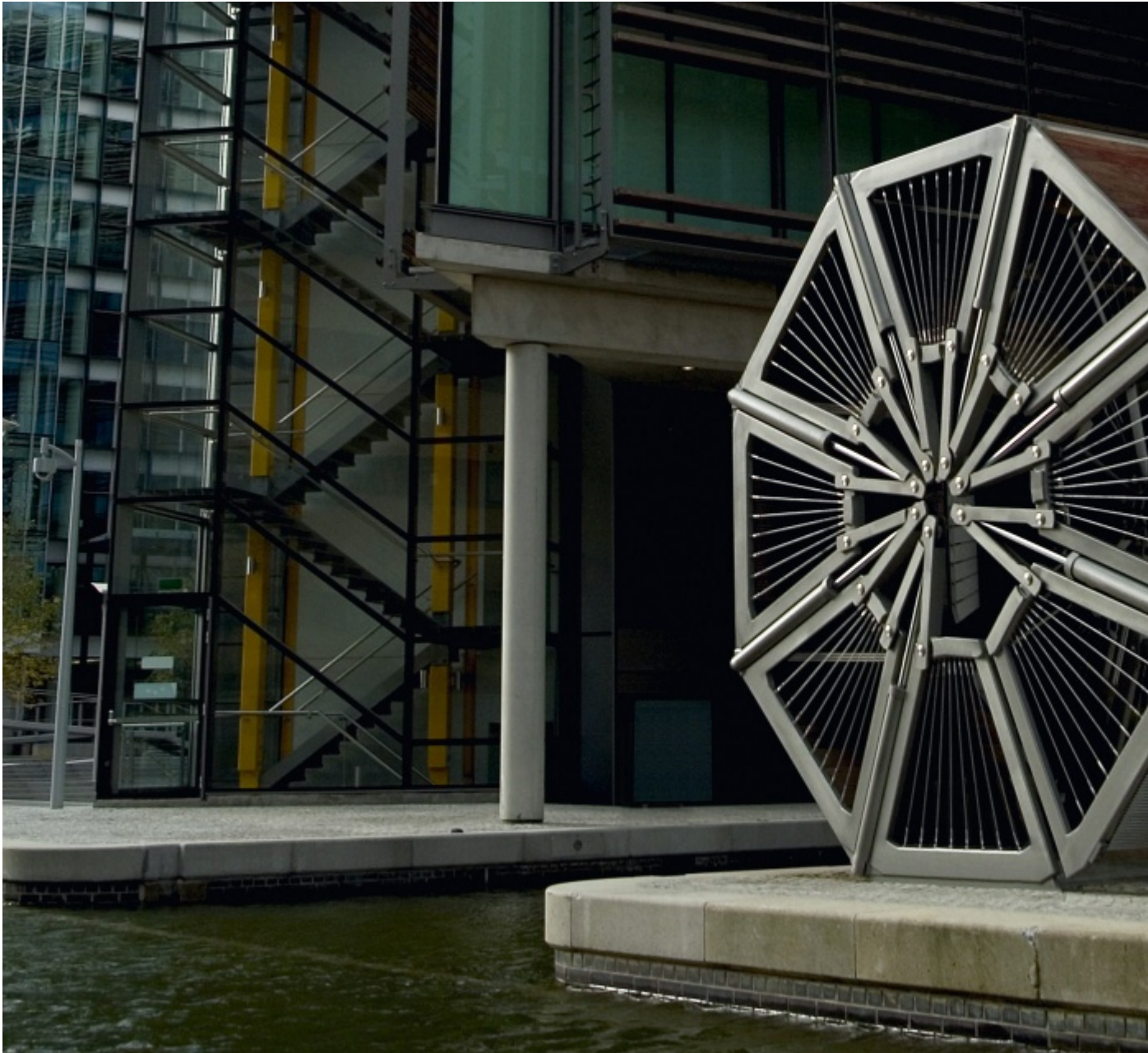


Strange Bridges Around the World
