Two divers have experienced a 'once in a lifetime' moment after spotting a pair of sunfish while diving off the coast of a popular Sydney beach.

Justin Ewan, along with his friend Joshua Ku, were diving from a jetski off the coast ofLong Reef beach in Sydney's northern beaches suburb of Collaroy on Sunday when hespotted two 'massive figures' swimming towards him.

Mr Ewan soon realised the dark figures were a pair of 'curious' sunfish measuring about 1.8metres in diameter.

'It was my turn to dive and I dove down to about 10 metres and looked straight aheadand noticed two massive figures coming towards me,' Mr Ewan told 9News.
