Henrick Carl from Denmark's Natural History Museum warns that while the pacu isn't normally dangerous to humans "there have been incidents where some men have hadtheir testicles bitten off"



A fish notorious for eating the testicles of unwary male swimmers has been found in European waters for the first time.

The pacu, a type of piranha fish noted for its "human-like" teeth, is usually found in the Amazon river basin. However, reports local news site Gentside, one of the eight-inchfish known as the "ball cutter" was caught by fisherman Einar Lindgreen in an eel traplocatedoff the south coast of Sweden.

According to Henrick Carl from Denmark's Natural History Museum; "The pacu is not normally dangerous to people but it has quite a serious bite.

He told Swedish news site The Local: "There have been incidents in other countries, such as Papua New Guinea where some men have had their testicles bitten off."
