The pale-yellow robin (Tregellasia capito) is a species of passerine bird in the family Petroicidae.It is endemic to eastern Australia. Itsnatural habitat is subtropical or tropical moist lowland forests.It is a nondescript bird with grey head and olive upperparts, white throatand yellow underparts.The sexes are similar. Two subspecies are recognised: the smaller nana from North Queensland, and thelarger and uncommon nominate race capito from southeast Queensland and northeasternNew South Wales. It is insectivorous.
