Originally began in Scotland.....the term golf itselfwas simply an acronym for Gentlemen Only Ladies Forbidden. The British Open is the only one of the 4major tournaments in professional golf that make upwhat is called the Grand Slam of Golf to actually beheld in Europe (the other 3 are the Masters, the USOpen, and the PGA championships).

The British Open is moved annaually. In 2002 it washeld at Muirfield Golf Links in East Lothian inScotland, in 2003 it will be at the Royal St. George'sin England, in 2004 at theTroon Golf Club inwestern Scotland, and in both 2001 & 2005 theBritish Opens were/will beheld at St. Andrews inScotland respectively.
