Entire Rooms Hidden Insideaa

This epic colossus, half man, half mountain, was erected in the late 1500s by renowned Italian sculptor Giambologna as a symbol of Italy'srugged Appenine mountains. This mountain god, fittingly named Appennino, stand 35 feet tall over the ground of the Villa di Pratolino inTuscany.

The rugged, mountainous statue hides a wonderful secret – his interior hides several rooms with different functions that made this colossuscome to life. The monster that his left hand holds spewed water from an underground stream, and it is rumored that space in his head wasmade for a fireplace which, when lit, would blow smoke out of his nostrils.

The park in which the colossus currently stands, Villa Demidoff, will be open on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays from 10AM until 7PM until theend of October.
