

The Rescue Of Two Poor Baby Elephants Trapped in The Swampaa

Two baby elephants have been rescued after falling into a muddy waterhole during a drought in Zimbabwe.

The elephants, Tess and Mana, were discovered by wildlife photographer Jens Cullmann at Mana Pools National Park last month and she alerted the 'wildlife is life' animal sanctuary.



One of the baby elephants grips a rescuer's leg with its trunk after it became trapped in the mud at the Mana Pools National Park, Zimbabwe, at the beginning of last month. It took rescuers around half a day to free them from the mud and they were treated before being loaded onto a plane.
