The Womb Cave is believed to be over 3000 years old.

Located in the Tangardak kaya rocky mountain area near the village of Nenkovо in Southern Bulgaria, the Womb Cave is a preservation site of the Thracian people.



Discovered in April 2001 by the livestock specialist Gumarov, the cave's exploration began a few years later when he announced his findings and Professor of Archaeology Nikolay Ovcharov initiated the research. According to studies, the cave dates back to the 9th-10th centuries BCE, from the Thracian era.
