Its strategic location overlooking important trade routes made it a coveted military outpost, leading to its control passing through the hands of several dynasties, including the Mughals and the Marathas. Notably, in the 17th century, Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj recognized its significance and fortified it, transforming it into a formidable bastion.
