## ? NEET PG 2025 Passing Marks (Cut-off Criteria)

To qualify in NEET PG, candidates must secure the minimum percentile score as prescribed by the National Board of Examinations and approved by the Medical Council of India.

The expected minimum qualifying percentiles are:

- General Category: 50th percentile
- SC/ST/OBC: 40th percentile
