

The Golden State Warriors have waived [Donta Scott](#)

Donta Scott had an outstanding five-year career with the Golden State Warriors, showcasing his versatility and consistency on the court. The 27-year-old forward averaged 11.2 points, 4.7 rebounds, and 1.3 assists per game while shooting 40.7% from the field and 33.5% from beyond the arc. Despite going undrafted in the 2024 NBA Draft, Scott's talent caught the attention of the Golden State Warriors, leading him to sign a two-year contract. This move is giving him an opportunity to prove himself at the professional level.

Via Michael Scotto of HoopsHype on September 17: "The Warriors have agreed to Exhibit 10 deals with Javan Johnson and Donta Scott, sources told @hoopshype."

According to the NBA's transaction log, Scott has now been waived.

Based on his contract being an Exhibit 10, Scott will likely be assigned to the Golden State Warriors (G League) to begin his rookie season.

If he is able to play well, the Warriors could end up giving him a two-year contract during the year.

Over his five seasons with Maryland, Scott had career averages of 11.2 points, 4.7 rebounds and 1.3 assists per contest while shooting 40.7% from the field and 33.3% from the three-point range in 162 games.

The Warriors are coming off a season where they were the Western Conference with a 46-36 record.

They lost to the Sacramento Kings in the play-in tournament.
