Muslin Sheets

One of the most essential components of any [Muslin Bedding](#) setup is a high quality set of sheets. Muslin material makes for sleep-inviting sheets due to its breathable cotton composition. Whether using muslin sheets in the summer to keep cool or during other seasons

with their lightweight touch, these sheets conform gently to the body without clinging. They are also durable enough for frequent washing without pilling or shrinking over time. When shopping for muslin sheets, thread count, weave structure, and sizing should be considered. Sets with thread counts ranging from 180-200 will balance softness and longevity well. A flat or fitted sheet paired with one or two pillowcases provides a breathable base layer for any mattress.

Muslin Comforters and Duvet Inserts
