

Exciting news for NBA fans! Check out the full player ratings for the Golden State Warriors on NBA 2K25.

The early release of NBA 2K25 is giving fans a head start on the new season, allowing them to test their favorite teams before October's tip-off. The Golden State Warriors, however, haven't fared particularly well in the latest player ratings. With only Stephen Curry (7th) and Draymond Green (65th) making the top 100, the Warriors join the Utah Jazz as the only Western Conference teams with fewer than three players on the list.



Despite this, the Warriors' depth remains notable, with 10 players rated between 75 and 80 overall. This presents both an opportunity and a challenge for head coach Steve Kerr, who will have to manage a deep but evenly rated roster. Balancing rotation has been a key discussion point during the offseason, and these ratings only add to the complexity of Kerr's task heading into the new season.



Below are the full ratings ranging from the franchise rookie in Curry to two-way contracted player Pat Spencer. Fellow two-way contracted players Daeqwon Plowden and Reece Beekman are not currently in the game on 'Play Now' mode, and nor is 52nd overall pick Quentin Post who has been confirmed as a 68 overall but is not currently contracted to the Golden State roster.
