Fiedler spent five years at Rice University, graduating this past season. The 6-11 forward, who reportedly agreed to a training camp deal in July, is a highly efficient big man with a diverse skill set. Although his offensive game has limitations, Fiedler excels as a rebounder and passer, and he can also contribute defensively by blocking shots.

Last season was arguably Fiedler's best with the Owls. He averaged 9.3 points per game while setting career highs in rebounds (9.2) and assists (5.2). He also shot an impressive 66.3% from the field and 61.2% from the free-throw line, racking up nine double-doubles along the way.
