

Did you know? Draymond Green thought an NBA insider was spying for LeBron and the Cavs! aa

Draymond Green has grown remarkably close to LeBron James over the years, largely due to the mutual respect they've developed through their time in the NBA Finals. However, there was a time when the Golden State Warriors forward would see red every time James was near. TNT's NBA insider, Chris Haynes, recalls one such moment when he found himself in the middle of this tense moment.



During an appearance on the Jefe Island podcast, Haynes described how tense the moment was and how paranoid Green was, to the point of being accused of spying for James and the Cleveland Cavaliers during his first time entering the Warriors' locker room.
