Lionel Messi nets 11-minute hat trick for Inter Miami before David Beckham speech

Lionel Messi fired home a 11-minute hat trick as Inter Miami smashed the MLS regular-season points record on Saturday night.

Messi, 37, only entered the game early in the second half after starting on the bench of next week's off.

In the span of about 30 minutes, the soccer icon had three goals – his first MLS hat trick – and an assist in a 6-2 rout over New England.

Teammate and good friend Luis Suarez also scored twice as Miami set MLS records for both most points and best winning percentage. Tata Martino's men finished with 74 points, one more than New England had in its record-setting season in 2021.

After the win Miami also celebrated the Supporters' Shield – which it won earlier this month on the road at Columbus – in a ceremony for the home fans as co-owner David Beckham made his way onto the field.
