Two extremely rare 'black' tigers have been spotted strolling around the Nandankanan National Park in eastern India.

The rare creatures have only been seen in the Odisha state and experts have in the past couple of years estimated there were as few as seven to eight of them left in the region.

Black tigers get their distinctive appearance due genetic mutation called pseudo-melanism where their dark stripe pattern fuses together on light orange-golden fur, often making their pelt look entirely black.
