1. Get Paid To Review Books

If you love sharing your thoughts about books, their themes, characters, and overall impact, consider becoming a freelance book reviewer online.

Websites like [Kirkus Reviews](#) and [Booklist](#) are always on the lookout for new book reviewers, and luckily, you don't necessarily need a journalism-related degree to get accepted by these book review websites.

You may be asked to provide samples of your previously written book reviews, though, so try to create several ones before applying.

Each book review you submit can pay \$15 to over \$50, depending on which platform you write for!

2. Become a Proofreader/Editor

Does the thought of reading books before they hit the bookstore aisle and contributing to the publishing process of books excite you?

In that case, [becoming a proofreader](#) or editor might be ideal for you.

Although these two roles vary from each other, proofreaders and editors, for the most part, are both responsible for catching grammatical or typographical mistakes present in texts before they're published.

Apart from being enjoyable for bookworms, these jobs often pay well, with proofreaders having a base salary of [\\$23.50](#) in Canada.
