As a Canadian with children, you may be eligible forseveral child benefits provided by the federal andprovincial governments. These benefits are designed to help families with the cost of raising children.

Here are three child benefits you can take advantage of in 2024:

#### Canada Child Benefit

The Canada Child Benefit (CCB) is a tax-freemonthly payment that helps eligible families with the cost of raising children under 18. The amount your eceive depends on several factors, including the number of children you have and your family income.

The maximum benefit you can get for each child isas follows:

- Child under 6 years of age: \$7,787 per year(\$648.91 per month)
- Child is 6 to 17 years of age: \$6,570 per year(\$547.50 per month)

You can use the CCB calculator to estimate howmuch you may be eligible for.

### Alberta Child and Family Benefit

The Alberta Child and Family Benefit (ACFB) is atax-free payment provided to families with childrenunder 18 years old in Alberta, per the CRA.

For the period spanning July 2024 to June 2025, eligible families can receive up to \$2,221 for their first child and lower benefits for subsequent children.

You can check your eligibility for the ACFB through the Alberta government website.

## Child Disability Benefit

The Child Disability Benefit is a tax-free monthly payment that helps families who care for a child under 18 years old with a severe and prolonged impairment in physical or mental functions.

The benefit is in addition to the CCB and can provide up to \$3,322 per year per child. You can check your eligibility and apply for the Child Disability Benefit through the CRA website.
