### Amazon Mechanical Turk

Amazon Mechanical Turk, or mTurk, is a crowdsourcing marketplace where Requesters outsource tasks (human intelligence tasks or HITs) to virtual Workers. Jobs available include transcribing and data entry. To access the platform, go to the [mTurk site](#) and create a Requester account.

### Scribie

Scribie is an audio/video transcription service that offers transcription jobs starting at \$1.25/min of audio, or \$5 to \$20 per audio hour. With 50K+ certified transcribers, it has paid out \$4 million and transcribed over 9 million minutes. To apply, go to the [signup page](#) and fill out the form.

### TranscribeMe

Freelance transcriber jobs are also available at the freelancer community TranscribeMe. The per-audio hour rate ranges from \$15-\$22, with transcription jobs lasting only 2-4 minutes. To start freelancing and get paid to type at home, go to the [TranscribeMe signup page](#).

### Babbletype

[Babbletype](#) produces transcription work for market research projects and requires highly skilled transcriptionists to work on more sophisticated formats. It currently offers transcription and translation jobs to long-term residents of the US, Canada, the UK, Australia, Ireland and New Zealand only.
