## Best Places to Raise a Family in Canada

Before we enumerate the best and safest cities to raise a family, below are a few notes regarding the data used in the list.

- Population figures are from the 2021 Census of Population from Statistics Canada.
- The [Crime Severity Index \(CSI\)](#) data is from Canada Crime Index. Higher figures mean a higher level of crime severity, while lower figures indicate community vitality.
- The Cost of Living, [Crime Index](#), and Safety Index data are from Numbeo.
  - Crime Index estimates the overall crime level in a city:
    - Scores lower than 20 – very low
    - Between 20 and 40 – low
    - Between 40 and 60 – moderate
    - Between 60 and 80 – high
    - Higher than 80 – very high
  - As for the Safety Index, if the value is 0, it means safety is perceived as very low. If the value is 100, there is a very high perception of safety.

With that, here are the 10 best cities to raise a family in Canada:

### 1. Trois-Rivières, Quebec

- Population: 139,163
- Crime Severity Index: 52.3
- Crime Index: 17.30
- Safety Index: 82.70

The city of Trois-Rivières (French for three rivers) in Quebec tops the list of the best cities in Canada to raise a family in. Located between Montreal and Quebec City, it is described as financially dynamic but a relatively quiet town with a low population.
