Accessory items like duty belts, bulletproof vests, and protective head gear further safeguard officers. Night visibility is also improved with fluorescent or retroreflective accents. Cut-resistant gloves and fire-resistant materials provide supplementary coverage. These protective additions allow officers to confront dangerous situations with greater confidence in their uniform's capabilities.

## Military Combat Uniform Advancements

From the early 20th century onwards, militaries shifted from dress-like uniforms to more functional combat attire. Modern camouflage patterns, developments in textile engineering, and new fabric blending techniques have completely transformed uniforms. Today's combat uniforms effectively disguise soldiers from detection while integrating the latest technological additions. Uniforms can also be treated with solutions to protect against chemical and biological threats on the battlefield. Furthermore, the incorporation of uniform accessories for items like body armor, weapon attachments, and equipment pouches has streamlined logistical burdens for troops.
